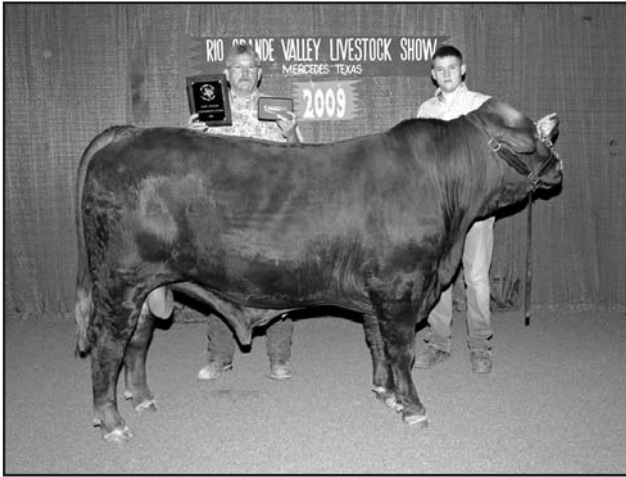




JR. RED BRANGUS DIVISION

SPECIAL RULES

1. The animals must be registered in the ARBA in the exhibitor's name and have a legible brand including a private herd number which shall correspond with the registration papers.
2. No false tails or tail heads may be used. No animal will be shown that has any foreign objects glued to or otherwise attached in a manner so as to alter its conformation, or change its appearance. The dying or artificial changing of the overall natural color of an animal is prohibited. Animals may not be brindled, black or have excessive white or white in front of the navel. Animals must be solid red with pink nose.

JR. RED BRANGUS DIVISION CONTINUED

3. Any animal found to have scars or evidence of incision surgical or otherwise, in the following area - head, navel, testicles, sheath or dewlap will be disqualified from showing. All animals must be polled. Surgical removal of scurs is a disqualification.
4. Judging of Red Brangus will be based on "desirable" characteristics as entered into the ARBA Bylaws, Article IV-Standard of Excellence for Red Brangus.
