SCHOLARSHIP**

The Rio Grande Valley Simbrah/Simmental Association will award at least one (1) \$750.00 Scholarship. The Scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding individual from the 2010 high school graduating class who has exhibited Junior Simbrah/Simmental cattle.

The following criteria will be used in making the selection of the recipient for the Scholarship:

1. Applicants must be a high school senior, who will graduate by the spring semester following the presentation of the Scholarship.
2. A complete Scholarship application must be returned to its designated address.
3. A Scholarship Selection Committee will be appointed to review applications.
4. All applicants will be personally interviewed by the Selection Committee.
5. Applications will be evaluated and applicants will be evaluated on a percentage point system.
6. Applicant's attitude and cooperativeness at the Show will be evaluated and considered.
7. Exhibitor's desire and interest in furthering his or her education beyond the high school level.
8. Applicants' high school grades.
9. Involvement in FFA and/or 4-H.
10. Involvement in extra curricular activities not including FFA and/or 4-H.
11. Needs of applicants.
12. Every applicant must have a sponsor, a sponsor being a member of the Rio Grande Valley Simbrah/Simmental Association.

**SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS:**

Four hundred dollars (\$400.00) of the money will be given upon presentation of evidence of entrance to an accredited college, university or vocational technical school of the recipient's choice and three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) upon successful completion of the first semester and evidence of enrollment in the second semester.

Scholarship must be used within one (1) year after graduation from high school.

If in the opinion of the Selection Committee there is no worthy exhibitor, the Scholarship will not be awarded.
