



CHAMPS FOR CHAMPIONS ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

REQUIREMENTS

1. Must have exhibited in the Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show within the prior three (3) years).
2. Have a minimum S.A.T. score of 1200 or a minimum score of 18 on the A.C.T. If minimum requirements are not met, the application will be returned to the applicant and applicant will be ineligible to compete for a scholarship.
3. Applicants must be a resident of Cameron, Hidalgo, Starr or Willacy County.
4. Must have made formal application to enroll in a college or university of higher education.
5. In addition to the basic requirements above, applicants must meet the entrance requirements of the college or university they plan to attend.
6. Scholarship winners will be announced at the annual Sale of Champions.
7. Scholarship Funds must be requested within 12 months after graduation. Funds will be forfeited after 12 months, unless approved by the scholarship committee.
